What is a FUN RUN?

Our FUN RUN is your Wellington PTA's new fundraiser. The RUN provides a fun, healthy way for kids to participate in fundraising, and a great event for kids and families to show their school spirit!

What does my child need to do?

Each student has a fundraising goal of \$50 and is asked to find sponsors for their RUN. Family, friends and neighbors make great sponsors. They can simply go online at wellingtonpta.org and make a direct donation in your child's name. Cash and checks also accepted.

What about company matching?

Matching is a great way to double your donations without extra work. Make sure to ask all your donors if their employer offers matching. Make sure to remind those donors to submit their donation through their company's donation matching process.

Are there any prizes or incentives this year?

Daily- Each child that brings in \$10 will receive a ticket. This ticket will be for a chance to win their favorite prize basket. Prize baskets will be on display in the library. For each additional \$10 they'll receive another ticket. The PTA will track each student and hand out all the tickets at lunch recess on Friday, Sept. 29th.

Class Competition- We have an exciting new class competition where the students will compete for the coveted Golden Paw Print! The Golden Paw Print will be awarded Monday/Wednesday/Friday during the collection period (September 19th – 29th) to the class that is winning the class competition. The winning class is determined by the average donation per student (total classroom donation \$/number of students in class). At the end of the collection period the winning class will be determined & will get to spray silly string at Mr. Bagnall at the Carnival!

If we reach our school goal- Mr. Bagnall will dye his hair the color of the winning class's grade color & every class will enjoy a special extra recess!! We'll also have a special guest delivering something new for the school that every student will enjoy.

What is happening at the Event?

We'll start the event by cheering on the students as they run, walk, skip our track. The run will start at 4:30pm sharp. After the run, we'll celebrate with games, prizes, inflatable obstacle courses, face paint, hot dog meal for purchase, free popcorn, and treats!

This event will also be a great time for parents to get information about the new school year, programs offered, Spirit wear, Membership, Helping Hands, Dads 'n dirt, and much more.

What should my child wear to the FUN RUN?

Students are encouraged to wear their Spirit Wear and/or their class color: Kindergarten = Purple; 1st Grade = Red; 2nd Grade = Orange; 3rd Grade = Yellow; 4th Grade = Green: 5th Grade = Blue

What happens if it rains?

Wellington's PTA FUN RUN is a rain or shine event. Please dress your child accordingly.
